GREATER DAYTON PUBLIC TELEVISION ("GDPT") SUBMITS THIS AMENDMENT TO WPTO'S 388 REPORT TO REFLECT 14 DAYS DURING THE QUARTER WHEN THE PSA REQUIREMENTS WERE NOT MET.  GDPT REGRETS TO INFORM THE FCC THAT STATION WPTO DID NOT AIR THE REQUIRED AMOUNT OF CONSUMER EDUCATION SPOTS DURING EACH DAY OF THE QUARTER DUE TO AN ERROR CAUSED BY THE PROTRAC SCHEDULING SOFTWARE. THE SOFTWARE FAILED TO SCHEDULE PSAS DURING THE PERIOD FROM NOV. 30 - DEC. 6, AND THE PERIOD FROM DEC. 14 - 20. THE SOFTWARE ERRORS RESULTED IN A SHORTAGE FOR WPTO'S DIGITAL CHANNEL ONLY, AS THE ANALOG CHANNEL IS NOT SIMULCAST AND WAS AIRING EXTRA, MANUALLY SCHEDULED, ANALOG-ONLY EDUCATIONAL SPOTS.  GDPT HAS TAKEN STEPS TO ENSURE FUTURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE CONSUMER EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS. GDPT HAS CONSULTED WITH THE PROTRAC SOFTWARE MANUFACTURER ABOUT THE ERROR AND THEY ARE INVESTIGATING THE SOURCE OF THE ERROR. GDPT HAS STARTED PULLING ADVANCE SCHEDULING REPORTS ON A WEEKLY BASIS TO DETECT AND PREVENT SCHEDULING ERRORS. GDPT HAS STARTED SCHEDULING ADDITIONAL, DTV SPOTS ON ITS DIGITAL SIGNAL.
